Staff Arrangements and Outreach

When we don't have regular Sunday worship services, offerings that support congregational ministries suffer. In addition, many of us face economic stress during this time. As result, the church's Executive Committee regrets that it must make the following staff adjustments effective April 1: both pastors will have salary cuts of 20%; the office administrator's hours will be cut by a quarter (she will work Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday each week); the custodian will continue under regular hours and do some deep cleaning at the church; the Choir Director is off until live worship services resume. The Committee will review arrangements on a monthly basis. Montezuma did make first quarter outreach offerings totaling \$9,141 to four Church of the Brethren and Shenandoah District partners. No further outreach will be made until the fourth quarter. The Executive Committee encourages regular giving to support church ministries as you are able through the mail or using an online giving option.

April Special Offering

April's special offering is the New Community Project's program "Give a Girl a Chance". Give a Girl a Chance aims to help girls and women in developing countries get the education and skills training they need to live happy, healthy and productive lives. Education is the key to later marriage and life opportunities.

Past videos are available on the website under "worship videos." **Pastor Gabe** is reaching out daily (M-F) with a 1 p.m. youth zoom video. He is also reading a live bedtime story via his Facebook page which young families (and old ones, too) can join every night at 7 (M-F). The Footsteppers Sunday School class is meeting by zoom each Sunday morning at 10. Other Sunday School classes can try this as well. The church office will consult with you on that. **Bible Study** is coming. Pastor David will host a Bible study beginning Wednesday, April 8, at 10 a.m. This will be by zoom; if you have online capability, contact him and he'll send you a link that will help you join the video Bible Study. An evening Bible study is next if there is interest. Either Wednesday or Thursday nights. Let Pastor David know if you have interest. The **Executive** Committee has met twice via video conference and plans to hold its meetings using that format in the weeks ahead. Other committees will use similar platforms for meetings.

This is a new world. One area of struggle for the pastors is the many members who don't have online access. We are striving to be in contact with you via phones and this newsletter. If you want to talk, please don't wait for us to call you. You call us – we'll be here (pastors' cell phones may be the best bet for now). Stay strong in Christ! Grace and peace.
