Church returns to Sanctuary worship July 5

Montezuma will hold its first sanctuary worship service on Sunday, July 5, at 9:30 a.m. This service follows two outdoor services at the Montezuma Braves ballpark June 21 and 28. A letter outlining principles and practices for the sanctuary service was mailed and emailed to the congregation in June.

While indoor services require greater care during this time of coronavirus pandemic, Montezuma is taking steps to be as safe as possible. We encourage everyone to wear a mask; to observe social distancing whether walking or seated; to use the automatic hand sanitizers provided in the meeting house; and to participate only if you are feeling healthy and well on the day of the service. The service will be shorter than a regular service and will not include singing - there will, however, be an opportunity to hear live instrumental music, including an organ/piano duet July 5. In lieu of offering plates, there will be an offering box; in place of bulletins, announcements and elements of worship will be projected. Ushers will make it possible for participants to enter the building without opening doors. Most inside doors that you need will be open. Ushers will direct participants to safe seating placement.

These are trying times. And yet these are not the first such times. Overall, we are able to do many important things, including worship and remaining connected with one another. Patience, flexibility, and hope are watchwords for us. Sanctuary services are a step in the right direction but if changes are needed, we will make them. Attendance at these services are a personal choice. We respect the decisions you make.
