MCOB Returns to Sanctuary Worship in July

After two months at the ballpark, Montezuma is returning to sanctuary worship beginning Sunday, July 4. By the time we gather, all federal and state coronavirus mandates concerning social gatherings will be expired. We look forward to being in the meeting house and enjoying the comfort and benefits it offers, such as musical instruments, better quality sound, and air conditioning. Services begin at 9:30 a.m.

<u>Sunday School</u> classes will meet following worship. Children will meet in the Fellowship room; church youth will meet in the sanctuary where they'll have access to projectors; the Agape class plans to gather in the choir room; the Cornerstone class meets downstairs in the board room; finally, the Footsteppers class will gather in the narthex area just beyond the elevator. These classes will begin approximately ten minutes after the end of worship. If other adult classes want to meet, please see Pastor David Miller.

Some things to consider: While most adults are vaccinated, for a variety of reasons some adults are not; children under twelve are not vaccinated either. Most children will be wearing masks when they gather for worship. They do this to protect others and to protect themselves, but it is obvious to children that they are in a different category. For that reason, some adults will be wearing masks in solidarity with children. Everyone is free to make their own decisions about mask wearing at this time. The pew ropes have been removed. Worshipers are free to sit anywhere but we encourage social distancing. Hymn singing will be limited. We still face some uncertainties, but give thanks for where we are concerning the pandemic.

Youth Workcamp July 11-14

Along with several other congregations, Montezuma is sponsoring a youth workcamp in the Harrisonburg area. Following a Sunday evening worship, meal and orientation at Pleasant Valley COB, youth will work with Vine & Fig at their Harrisonburg gardens off of North Main Street and one day at the group's Jubilee Climate Farm in Mt. Clinton. Youth will learn how different plants and gardening practices restore nutrients to the soil and capture harmful CO2 from the atmosphere. Youth will meet and work alongside refugees from Africa and South America and may help with a summer school gardening program in Harrisonburg. Five Montezuma youth are participating.

July/August Witness Offerings

July's outreach offering benefits the Bridgewater Area Food Pantry and People Helping People. Gifts of food such as canned meats, veggies, and fruit, cereal, soup, peanut butter and pasta go directly to the Food Pantry. All cash gifts go to People Helping People, a county-wide and city relief agency that provides utility and rent support to families in our area.

August's focus is Bridge of Hope. The mission statement for Bridge of Hope is to "engage Christian faith communities in ending family homelessness through neighboring relationships that demonstrate Christ's love." At risk or homeless families are connected to community volunteers for support and mentoring.
