Montezuma Youth Hold their First Fastnacht Fundraiser


The Montezuma Youth tried something new this year by selling Fastnachts for Shrove Tuesday.

We want to thank the congregation for the great support shown as this fundraiser will help defer costs for traveling to Colorado for the National Youth Conference this coming July. We presold over 70 dozen Fastnachts and grossed over \$850 thanks to the amazing support of our generous congregation. It was a big undertaking to try something new, but it was a great time bonding with each other which we have missed over the past twenty-four months.

Fastnacht Day is an annual Pennsylvania Dutch celebration that falls on Shrove Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday. The word translates to "Fasting Night" or "Almost Night" in English. The tradition is to eat the very best foods, which are part of the German tradition, and much of them, before the Lenten fast. There are several types of Fastnachts; some made with yeast, some made with baking powder, and some made with potatoes and yeast. All are slightly crispy on the outside and not as sweet as standard doughnuts. We made ours with baking powder and potato flakes.
