God's love was revealed among us in this way: God sent his only Son into the world so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:9-10

As a result of the ecclesiastical and astronomical rules used to calculate the date of Easter each year, Ash Wednesday falls on February 14th this year—Valentine's Day. One could say that this is purely coincidental, but I think it is a coincidence with significance. Ash Wednesday is the beginning of Lent, the 40-day period before Easter –the celebration of God's ultimate act of love for us. 1 John 4:8 tells us that God is love. God's very essence is love—he cannot help but to love. That love is shown in so many ways:

--God created us. Colossians 1:16 tells us that "All things have been created through him and for him.

--God sustains us. Colossians 1:17 teaches, "He himself is before all things, and in him all things hold together."

--God saves us. Ephesians 2:8-9 says, "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your doing; it is the gift of God."

--God has prepared an eternal home for us with him. "In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am there you may be also."

The season of Lent is a time to reflect on God's love for us and to respond to that love by examining our own hearts and lives. It is a time to allow God's grace and forgiveness to cleanse us of any sin so that we might come before our God with pure hearts; hearts ready to receive the fullness of God's love. Anointing for the forgiveness of sins will be offered at our Ash Wednesday service. May we all take seriously the preparation for the celebration of Easter.
